## **Prevention, Protection, Accountability Safe Environment**

### **OFFICE OF THE VICAR FOR PRIESTS**

To assure the safety of all our children and vulnerable people in our diocese, all ministers and volunteers go through a process of background checks and training. This is especially true of all priests and deacons who minister with us.

No visiting priest or deacon may minister in the Stockton Diocese, even for individual sacraments such as a baptism or a wedding, without first providing a current letter of good standing from his Bishop or Religious Superior.

All deacons and priests who have an assignment in the diocese go through a rigorous and thorough series of background checks, both national and international. For international clergy, a company by the name of Hire Right is contracted to do a thorough background check which includes criminal, educational, and employment history. An investigation is conducted of past ministry and references, as well as the mandatory fingerprinting and safe environment training required of all ministers and volunteers working with our children. In addition, all clergy are required to read and sign a Pastoral Code of Conduct upon accepting an assignment within the Diocese of Stockton. They are also provided with ongoing opportunities for training through an annual retreat and workshops to promote their human and spiritual and ministerial development.

The Office of the Vicar for Priests oversees all these processes of investigation and certification of priests and deacons in our diocese. Visit the Office of the Vicar for Priests on our diocesan website:

## **Prevención, Protección y responsabilidad Ambiente Seguro**

### **OFICINA DEL VICARIO PARA SACERDOTES**

Para garantizar la seguridad de nuestros niños y de la gente más vulnerable en nuestra diócesis, todos los ministros y voluntarios pasan por un proceso de investigación personal y de entrenamiento. Esto es especialmente cierto en lo que se refiere a los sacerdotes y diáconos que tienen ministerio entre nosotros.

Ningún sacerdote o diácono visitante puede tener ministerio en la Diócesis de Stockton, aun para una sola vez p.ej. para un bautismo o una boda, sin que antes provea una carta válida de buena conducta escrita por su Obispo o Superior Religioso.

Todos los diáconos y sacerdotes que tienen un ministerio en la diócesis se someten a una serie rigurosa y seria de chequeos de conducta, nacional e internacional. Para el clero de otro país, ha sido contratada una compañía llamada Hire Right (Emplee Bien, Escoja bien) para hacer un chequeo que incluye lo criminal y educacional, y el historial de trabajo. Se lleva a cabo una investigación de ministerio en el pasado y referencias, como también la toma de huellas dactilares obligatoria, además del entrenamiento para ambiente seguro, requerido de todos los ministros y voluntarios que trabajan con niños. Además de firmar el Código Pastoral de Conducta cuando se acepta un Ministerio en la Diócesis de Stockton. También se les ofrecen oportunidades para entrenamiento a través del retiro anual y talleres que promueven su desarrollo humano, espiritual y ministerial.

La oficina del Vicario para Sacerdotes supervisa todos estos procesos de investigación y certificación para sacerdotes y diáconos en nuestra diócesis.
